JAMES J. DIXON NAMED CHIEF COUNSEL FOR CON EDISON DEVELOPMENT AND CON EDISON ENERGY

VALHALLA, NY – November 29, 2011: James J. Dixon has been named Chief Legal Counsel for ConEdison Development, which develops renewable and energy infrastructure assets, and ConEdison Energy, a wholesale energy company. In this capacity he will oversee the legal services for these two companies which are subsidiaries of Consolidated Edison, Inc. (NYSE: ED), one of America's largest investor-owned energy companies. In addition, he assumes responsibility for compliance activities for all of ConEdison's Competitive Energy Businesses.

Mr. Dixon previously served as Vice President of Energy Services for ConEdison Solutions, an energy services company that is also a subsidiary of Con Edison Inc. He had previously held the position of Vice President and General Counsel for that company.

He is a registered professional engineer in New York State and a retired major from the U.S. Army Reserve, where he commanded a Combat Heavy Engineer Company and was Executive Officer for an Engineer Battalion. Mr. Dixon is an honors graduate of both the basic and advanced officer courses at the United States Army Engineer School.

Mr. Dixon received a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from Manhattan College and a law degree from New York Law School. He is admitted to practice law in New York and Washington D.C. Mr. Dixon is a member of the New York State Bar Association and the Association of Corporate Counsel.

In 2010, Mr. Dixon was selected Chairman of the National Association of Energy Service Companies (NAESCO), the leading energy services industry trade organization that promotes energy efficiency nationwide on behalf of more than 75 member companies. He will continue as NAESCO's chairman through the end of his term in November 2012.
